PORTABLE DOCUMENT FORMAT (*.pdf)

Portable Document Format (PDF) is a file format developed by Adobe to present documents, including text formatting and images, in a manner independent of application software, hardware, and operating systems.



Sharable Content Object Reference Model (SCORM)

Importing to i3 using SCORM xAPI AICC and cmi5

To import a course package, it needs to be zipped up (.zip) and needs to be either a SCORM, AICC or xAPI course package.

A **SCORM** package needs to have a imsmanifest.xml file which describes the course and its content.

A **xAPI** package needs to have a tincan.xml file and needs to send xAPI statements to the SCORM Cloud Learning Record Store.

An AICC package needs to be zipped up with the 4 AICC descriptor files (AU, CRS, CST, & DES).

A **cmi5** package must include a 'cmi5.xml' file which includes a list of assignable units (AU) which when launched will communicate with the SCORM Cloud Learning Record Store via xAPI.

Quiz Only

A content entry can be used in the system to just convey a quiz using the i3 systems quiz engine.

Video Text Track (*.vtt)

This is the file type to upload subtitles to a video entry in the library.

Subtitle Edit is an open-source program used to generate and edit SRT and VTT files for subtitles.
